

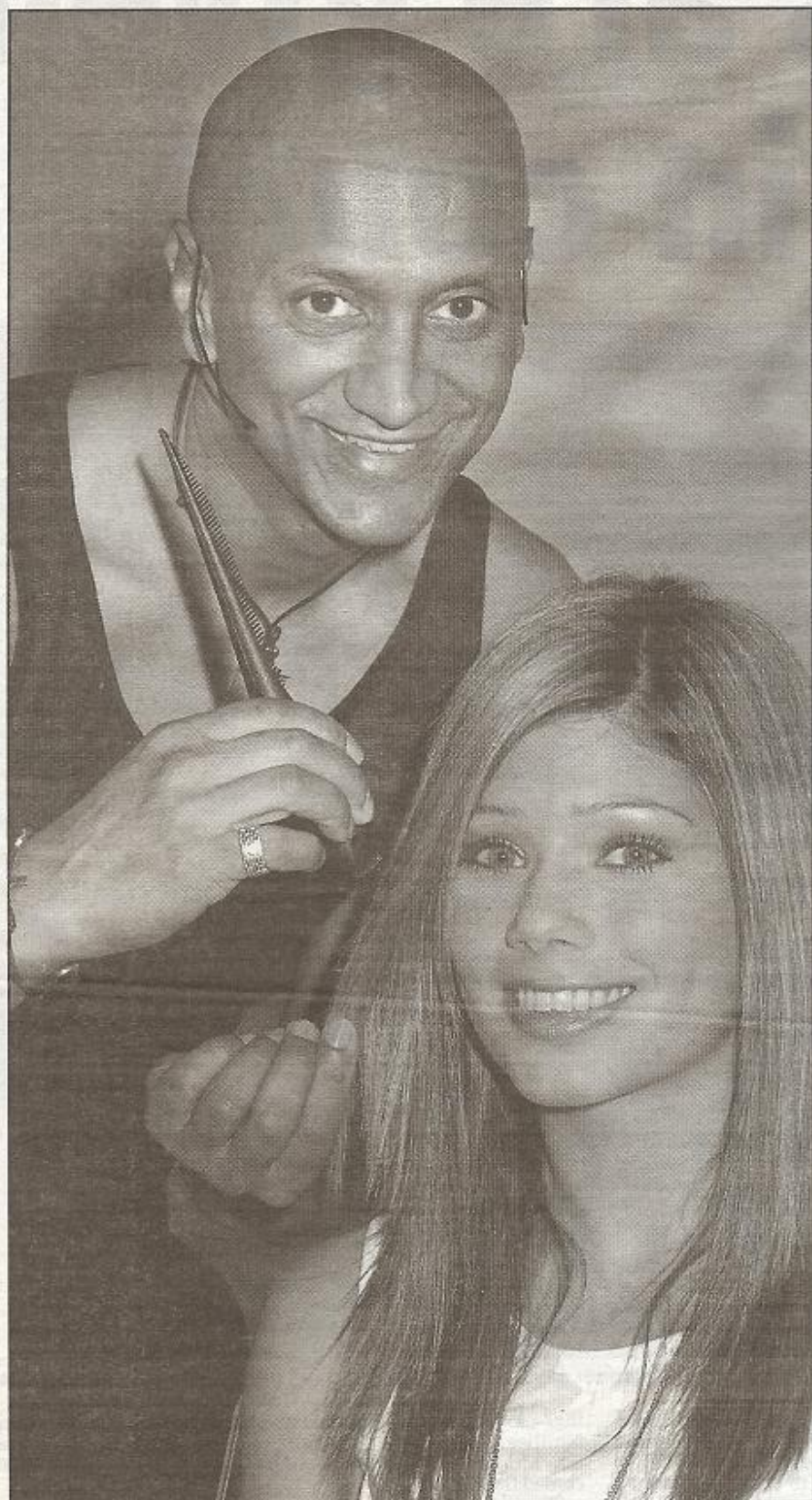

'Broken-glass' trim a snip at £1,000 a head

A NEW way of cutting hair started with... a piece of a broken beer bottle.

But now customers will have to part with £1,000 for the privilege of having their hair cut by Frank Bisson's world-first glass blades.

The hair stylist, who runs Wow! hair salon on Wilbraham Road, Chorlton, is launching glass hair-cutting tools that threaten to leave more conventional croppers trailing in his wake.

The stylist, whose customers include Amir Khan and Coronation Street actress Nikki Sanderson, has patented the FB1 Glass Hair Designer which he's about to franchise around the world.

Frank, uncle of ex-Corrie actor Chris Bisson, said: "I perfected the glass cutting technique with a broken piece of a Budweiser bottle. I found glass leaves the hair in wonderful order.

"I have been working on this quietly for seven years. I plan to charge celebrities £1,000-£10,000 for a haircut and donate the money to charitable causes."
