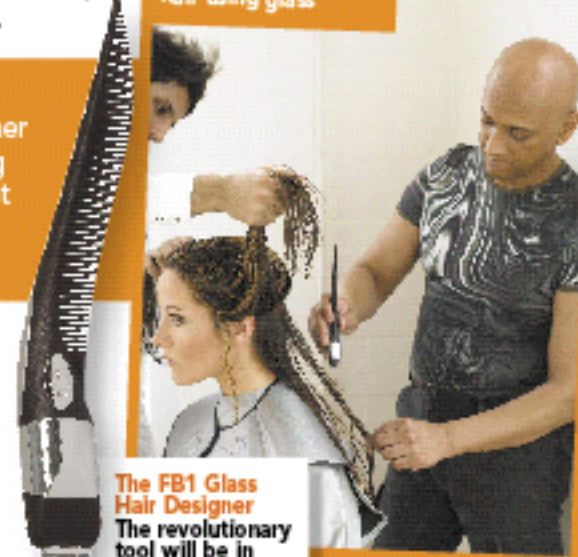

**HOW IT WORKS:** Because of its super-sharpness, glass cuts hair into a pointed rather than blunt end, which leaves the hair looking much softer. It's used like a razor and is great for adding volume to fine hair, as well as removing weight from thick hair.

**THE RESULT:** After wetting and combing through Rebekah's long locks, Frank sliced into her hair to give it more bounce, movement and root lift. Because of her new layers, Rebekah can wear her hair straight and sexy without it falling flat, plus, it will hold glam curls all night – perfect for the red carpet!
